The Northwest Michigan Cancer Advisory Board was established to help residents in its service region of Crawford, Kalkaska, Lake, Manistee, Mason, Mecosta, Missaukee, Newaygo, Oceana, Osceola and Wexford counties to access cancer-related services and prevention opportunities. Representatives of the Advisory Board meet quarterly and include: District Health Department 10, Memorial Medical Center of West Michigan, West Michigan Regional Blood and Cancer Center, Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, Michigan Department of Community Health, Spectrum Health Reed City Hospital, Mercy Hospital Cadillac and Grayling, Kalkaska Memorial Health Center, Care Linc, Breast Friends of Cadillac Support Group, Gerber Memorial Health Services, Family Health Care of Lake and Newaygo, Mecosta County Medical Center and its Wheatlake Cancer and Wellness Center, West Shore Medical Center, the American Cancer Society and the Central Michigan District Health Department.
