KALKASKA COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT OPENS TEMPORARY OFFICES

Limited services available at All Seasons Resort and Church of Christ

Kalkaska, MI (April 24, 2017) – While clean up and restoration continue due to flooding at District Health Department #10 (DHD #10) in Kalkaska, two temporary locations are now open for limited services.

WIC services are available at the Church of Christ located at 1725 Kalkaska Road in Kalkaska.

Environmental health, scheduled immunizations, family planning supply pick up and education services are now available at the All Seasons Resort located at 706 S. Cedar Street in Kalkaska.

For new and existing patients needing full clinical services for **family planning, breast and cervical cancer control**, and **sexually transmitted diseases** can attend clinics at DHD #10's Wexford and Crawford county offices until full services are restored in Kalkaska. Estimated time frame for re-opening the Kalkaska office is three to four weeks.
