

OPEN ENROLLMENT FOR THE HEALTH INSURANCE MARKETPLACE HAS BEGUN

November 5, 2018 – Open enrollment for the Health Insurance Marketplace is November 1, 2018 through December 15, 2018. Coverage begins January 1, 2019 after you pay your first premium.

If you are already insured through the Marketplace (also known as HealthCare.gov), you should update your information and make sure your current plan is still the best one for you, your family, and your budget. Open enrollment is the only time to enroll in or change plans for 2019, unless you are eligible for a Special Enrollment Period at another time due to life circumstances such as a birth, death, job loss, etc.
