

Hepatitis A Is Spreading And Can Kill... ARE YOU NEXT?

You are at risk for hepatitis A infection if:

- ⇒ You are a man who has sex with men.
- ⇒ You use any kind of illegal drugs or take drugs differently than prescribed.
 - ⇒ You have been in jail recently.
- ⇒ You are homeless or move from place to place a lot.
- ⇒ You work with or spend a lot of time with the people listed above.
- ⇒ You might have been exposed to the hepatitis A virus in the past two weeks.

There is a large hepatitis A outbreak taking place right now in many areas of Michigan. Hepatitis A is a serious liver disease caused by a virus that is found in the feces (poop) of infected people. Hepatitis A can easily spread from person-to-person and causes liver disease that lasts from a few weeks to several months. Many people infected with hepatitis A need to be hospitalized and in some cases, **people die because of hepatitis A.**

What are the symptoms of hepatitis A?

Nausea and Vomiting



Stomach Pains

Loss of Appetite



Fatigue/Tired

Jaundice (yellowing of the skin or eyes)



Dark urine,
pale stool, diarrhea

Fever
