

TITLE X: THE NATION'S PROGRAM FOR AFFORDABLE BIRTH CONTROL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

More than four million people rely on federal Title X funding to access contraceptive and other essential health care!

July 1, 2019 -- Lake County, Michigan -- For almost 50 years Title X been providing affordable reproductive health care and birth control to people with low incomes, who couldn't otherwise afford health care services.

Title X federal funding ensures that every person- regardless of where they live, how much money they make, their background, or whether they have health insurance- has access to basic, quality preventative reproductive health care.

More than four million people rely on affordable birth control and reproductive health care services funded by Title X. This competitive grant program allows access to primary and preventative health care services such as, wellness exams, birth control, contraception education, testing and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases and HIV and lifesaving cervical and breast cancer screenings.

District Health Department #10, a recipient of the Title X grant, strives to empower people of all ages and genders to take control of their sexual health. A wide range of birth control methods are available to our clients in ten counties including Crawford, Kalkaska, Lake, Manistee, Mason, Mecosta, Missaukee, Newaygo, Oceana, and Wexford.
