



DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT #10 REPORTS A CLUSTER OF COVID-19 CASES AT AGRICULTURAL FARMS IN MISSAUKEE COUNTY

April 23, 2020 – District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) is working closely with several agricultural farms in Missaukee County that have COVID-19 clusters among workers. DHD#10 is currently investigating the situation and performing contact tracing to determine any close contacts with infected individuals.

“We are actively working with these farms to provide guidance and education in order to prevent further spread,” said Kevin Hughes, DHD#10 Health Officer. “We continue to monitor the situation to ensure the safety and well-being of all residents in the community.”
