

## SECOND CRAWFORD COUNTY RESIDENT DIES FROM COVID-19

April 17, 2020 – District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) received notification on a second death of a Crawford County resident attributed to COVID-19. The individual is a female in her 80's who resided in a long-term care facility where she died.
