



MICHIGAN ATTORNEY GENERAL ISSUES CONSUMER ALERT FOR NATIONAL LIFELINE PROGRAMS

May 18, 2020 – Michigan Attorney General Dana Nessel has recently announced a simplified application process for the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) National Lifeline programs.

The Michigan and Federal Lifeline programs allows individuals at or below 135 percent of the federal poverty level to obtain a discount on monthly phone, internet, or phone and internet bundled services.

Individuals who have lost their income due to COVID-19 need only fill out a waiver, available through June 30, that will allow proof of income eligibility through a notice of unemployment benefits or similar official document.

In addition to this simplified application process, current Lifeline participants who are up for recertification have been allowed an extension to do so through June 30, 2020 without penalty.
