

DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT #10 PROVIDES CLARIFICATION ON HOW TO FILE COMPLAINTS RELATING TO COVID-19

August 21, 2020 – District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) has recently seen an increase in inquiries on how to file health and safety complaints during COVID-19 and would like to provide clarification on how residents may initiate the process.

It is important that with each complaint, details such as location, date, type of violation, risks, any evidence that the violation occurred, contact information of the violator and individual contact information for follow-up be provided.

- For complaints about businesses not masking, contact MIOSHA at 855-723-3219 or visit the <u>'How to file a Complaint with MIOSHA'</u> webpage.
- For complaints about groceries, farmer's markets, or big box stores with food, contact the Department of Agriculture at 800-292-3939 or email MDA-Complaints@Michigan.gov.
- For complaints about restaurants, contact the local health department. If a local health department is unknown, visit the <u>Michigan Association for Public Health</u> <u>Directory</u> webpage.
- For complaints about licensed facilities such as nursing homes, cosmetologists, et. visit LARA's <u>'Professional Licensing Complaints'</u> webpage or email <u>BPL-Complaints@michigan.gov</u>.
- For **miscellaneous complaints**, contact local law enforcement or Michigan State Police.
- For major violations of emergency orders or if local law enforcement won't respond, email Attorney General Nessel at <u>AG-COVID19@michigan.gov</u> or visit the State of Michigan's 'Consumer Complaint/Inquiry Form' webpage.
