

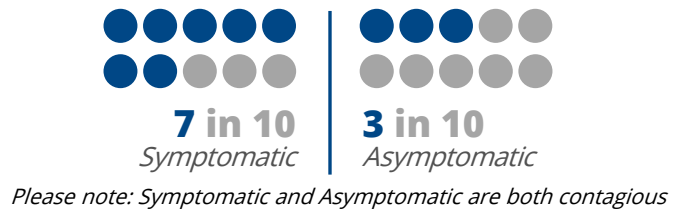
COVID-19 Jurisdiction Wide Monthly Summary – July 2020

The purpose of this monthly summary is to provide you with more information regarding cases referred to the health department over the past month. Information is obtained through the Michigan Disease Surveillance System (MDSS). Data provided is for confirmed cases only unless otherwise noted as probable.

There was an increase in confirmed COVID-19 cases this month.



More than half of the cases were symptomatic during their course of illness.



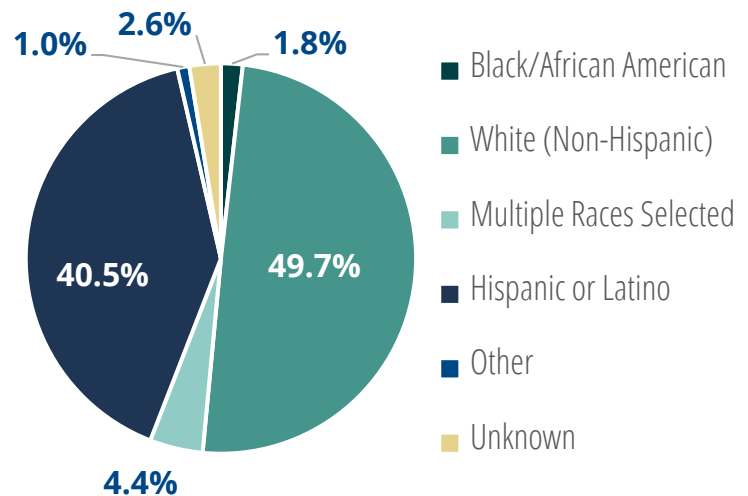
The most common symptom among all cases was fatigue/lethargy/weakness.



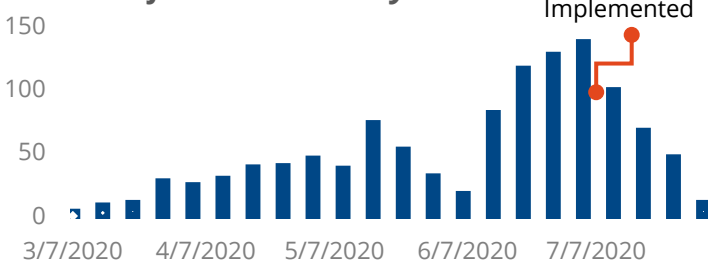
Known source of exposure has been identified for more than half of the cases.

- 140 cases are associated with a named outbreak
- Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 30 cases are community contacts meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case not within the same household
- Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 62 cases are household contacts meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case within the same household
