
There was an increase in confirmed COVID-19 cases this month.




Known source of exposure to another positive COVID-19 case has been identified for less than half of the cases.

- 1 case is associated with a named outbreak
- 2 Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 1 case is a community contact meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case not within the same household.

More than half of the cases were symptomatic during their course of illness.




Please note: Symptomatic and Asymptomatic are both contagious
