

## DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT #10 REPORTS THE SECOND DEATH FROM COVID-19 IN MANISTEE COUNTY

September 10, 2020 – District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) received notification that a Manistee County resident died from complications due to COVID-19 on Monday, September 7. The individual was a male in his 70's who passed away at Spectrum Health - Meijer Heart Center in Grand Rapids.

“Our deepest sympathies go out to the family who lost their loved one,” said Kevin Hughes, Health Officer for DHD#10. “We continue to urge the public to be vigilant in preventing the spread of COVID-19 by wearing a proper face covering, social distancing, avoiding touching your face, and washing your hands often.”
