

DHD#10 CHANGING TO WEEKLY COVID-19 UPDATES STARTING MONDAY

April 5, 2021 – For about a year, District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) has provided daily COVID-19 updates on our website, data dashboard, on social media, and to our community stakeholders. Beginning Monday, April 5, DHD#10 will be changing to a weekly COVID-19 update that will provide data to include Sunday through Saturday from the previous week. The April 5 update will include data from Friday and Saturday, April 2 and 3. The update on Monday, April 12, will include data from Sunday, April 4 through Saturday, April 10.

“As we continue to focus efforts on vaccine distribution, contact tracing, and COVID-19 prevention, we felt the time was right to change to a weekly update,” stated Kevin Hughes, Health Officer for DHD#10.
