

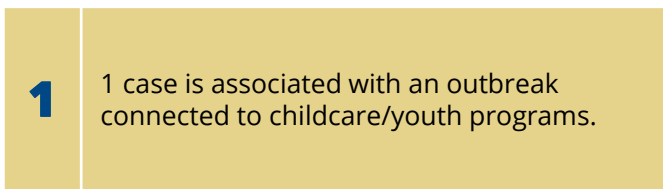
COVID-19 Crawford County Monthly Summary – July 2021

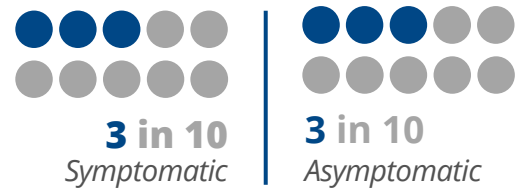
There were the same amount of confirmed COVID-19 cases this month as last month.

Less than half of the cases were symptomatic during their course of illness.*

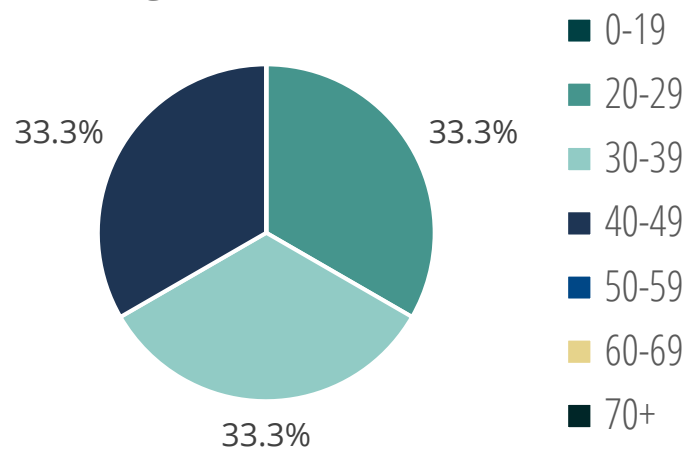


Please note: Symptomatic and Asymptomatic are both contagious

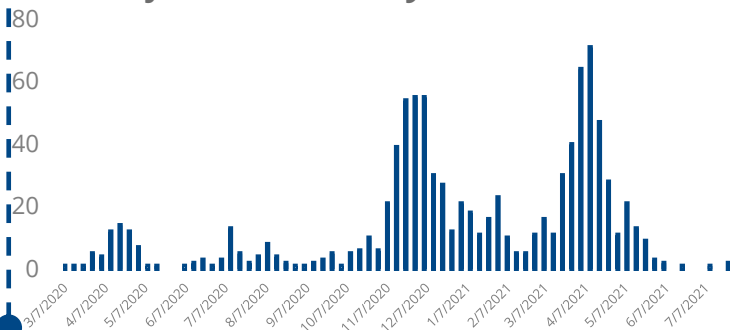
Of those with symptoms, the most common symptoms were fever, chills, muscle ache, shortness of breath, fatigue, and congestion.
