

PFIZER BOOSTER NOW AVAILABLE FOR ANYONE 16+

District Health Department #10 Promotes COVID-19 Booster

December 14, 2021 - Following the CDC's approval, and with support from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) is urging anyone aged 16 and up to get the Pfizer booster dose if they have already received their full COVID-19 vaccine sequence. COVID-19 boosters can be given regardless of the manufacturer of the vaccine initially received and can also be given with the flu vaccine.

DHD#10's Health Officer, Kevin Hughes, stated that, "While COVID-19 infections continue to rise, the COVID-19 vaccine and booster dose can help lessen the spread of COVID-19 and make significant gains toward getting out of this pandemic."

To be eligible to receive a COVID-19 booster dose, you must have received your full sequence of the COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months prior to receiving the booster dose. Currently, the only authorized booster for those under the age of 18 is from Pfizer.

Please bring your vaccine card or immunization record and a government issued ID. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to receive both their COVID-19 vaccine and booster.
