

DHD#10 ANNOUNCES PRESCRIPTION FOR HEALTH PROGRAM IN KALKASKA COUNTY

July 12, 2022 - District Health Department #10 (DHD#10), the Kalkaska Farmer's Market, and MSU-Extension are kicking off the summer by announcing the Prescription for Health Program in Kalkaska County.

Prescription for Health is a program that aims to increase fruit and vegetable consumption and support healthy lifestyle behavior change among people who are at an increased risk for chronic disease.

In Kalkaska County, residents can enroll in the Prescription for Health Program in one of two ways:

- 1. By visiting Maegan Sorenson at the DHD#10 booth in Railroad Square Pavilion at the Kalkaska Farmer's Market on Tuesdays from 2:00-6:00pm.

Participants of the Prescription for Health program can attend as many classes as they would like and may earn up to \$100 worth of vouchers to be used at the Kalkaska Farmer's Market. In addition to vouchers, first time participants who visit Maegan at the Kalkaska Farmer's Market will receive a reusable thermal shopping tote with kitchen tools inside.
