DHD #10 Continues to Offer COVID-19 Testing Clinics

October 28, 2022 – District Health Department #10 (DHD#10) wants to remind residents of their COVID-19 testing options. DHD#10, in collaboration with HONU Management, is supporting COVID-19 testing clinics in eight counties throughout the jurisdiction.

“COVID-19 cases are still present in our communities, so it’s important that we remind folks that testing locations are available,” said DHD#10’s Health Officer, Kevin Hughes. “We also have the new COVID-19 bivalent boosters available, it’s never too late to get vaccinated.”

DHD#10 now a limited supply of COVID-19 at-home tests. At-home test kits are offered at no charge and are available at each DHD#10 office on a first come, first served basis. Individuals are asked to take one kit per person, and up to four kits per household. Each kit has two tests inside and expire March 2023. Test kits are also available for purchase at most pharmacies. Be sure to call your pharmacy ahead of time, as demand remains high.
