GENERAL SERVICES

CLEAN WORKS HARM REDUCTION

A syringe access/needle exchange program which provides sterile, personal substance use equipment to participants.

OVERDOSE PREVENTION AND RESPONSE

Educate lay community members how to prevent, recognize, and respond to an opioid overdose with naloxone hydrochloride.

RECOVERY COACHING

Assists participants with substance use disorder in accessing community health and social services, such as medical and mental services, housing, food, and transportation.

HIV/HEPATITIS C (HCV) PREVENTION

Provides free rapid HIV/HCV testing, counseling, and referrals along with safe sex supplies (i.e. external and internal condoms and lube).

EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES

Provides linkage to medical care for people newly diagnosed with HIV or people living with HIV who are not actively seeking medical treatment.

HIV MEDICAL CASE MANAGEMENT

Assists participants living with HIV in accessing community health and social services, such as medical and mental services, housing, food, and transportation.

TOBACCO REDUCTION PROGRAM

Provides support, education, and assistance in accessing community resources to reduce tobacco usage in people living with HIV.

PrEP NAVIGATION SERVICES

Assists participants with education and access to pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) medication. PrEP is a medication that is used to reduce the transmission of HIV.

HIV EDUCATIONAL DINNERS

Discuss topics related to HIV prevention and treatment, including stigma. Opened to people living with HIV, their partners, and service providers.
