Duties:

- Works independently and provides public health nursing services to individuals and families with special needs through the Children's Special Health Care Services program (CSHCS) and Elevated Blood Lead Nurse Case Management.
- Collaborates and consults with multidisciplinary and multi-agency teams to achieve desirable outcomes for families and communities.
- Promotes health of individuals and families and community through advocacy, education, and/or counseling.
- Utilizes skilled nursing to provide annual Plans of Care and Case Management services for families.
- Organizes and provides assigned program-specific nursing services to individuals and/or families, directly or through referrals to appropriate services.
- Documents services utilizing program forms and/or electronic health records, in accurate and timely manner.
- Assesses, plans, implements, and evaluates services and outcomes of care on an ongoing basis.
- Exercises significant independence and initiative in performance of responsibilities.
- Receives general administrative direction.

Requirements:

- Graduation from accredited professional nursing program.
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing preferred.
- Current license to practice as registered nurse from Michigan Board of Nursing.
- Ability to enter, retrieve and manage client data, notes, and care plans in electronic health records, and other on-line or network databases or logs.
- Ability to plan and organize own work and accomplish multiple tasks.
- Cultural sensitivity and ability to work with diverse communities and families.
- Reliable transportation with valid Michigan driver's license and certificate of insurance to travel to other locations for work, training, meetings, and/or home or site visits.
