- Licensed Master of Social Work or Licensed Professional Counselor by State of Michigan Preferred.
- Will consider a Limited Licensed Counselor or a Limited Master of Social Work.
- Experience providing child/adolescent/family counseling or social work.
- Communication skills necessary to interact appropriately with children/parents/guardians, co-workers, school staff, and the public.
