General Responsibilities

- Through home visits and in clinic and community settings, works 1 on 1 with clients to secure information such as medical, psychological, and social factors contributing to client's situation.
- Records information in database, works to identify and navigate resources to support the client and eliminate barriers to good health.
- Advocates for clients and acts as a liaison between clients and other service providers.
- Helps clients and families understand, accept and follow medical recommendations.
- Provides healthcare enrollment services, Medicaid Outreach, and DHD#10 services outreach in community settings.
- Covers primarily Lake County with portions of eastern Mason County and southeast Manistee County.
